LEGISLATION

n Act Relative to Homes For All.

Senate version (S.866 & H.1799 sponsor, Senator Sonia Chang-Diaz & Representative Liz Miranda, assigned to the Joint Committee of Housing and Judiciary. Hearings scheduled for January 2021. Find your legislator, ask to vote to pass the bill and sign our petition.

H.4071 "An Act securing housing options for eligible tenants with a history of criminal justice Involvement", bill sponsor Nika Elugardo, was assigned to the Joint Committee of Housing.

The legislation states that the Dept. of Neighborhood Development shall partner with established community based organizations, led by directly affected individuals, to provide State vouchers to individuals reentering after incarceration. Find your <u>legislator</u> & sign our petition.


Our Hands on Defense (HOD) Model is designed to disrupt the process Public Housing Authorities use to exclude those with a criminal record.




NASHUA STREET JAIL COVID SURVEY

We surveyed over 100 men and women being released on bail at the Nashua Street and South Bay Jails. The following data points are the results of a 6 month survey data collection.










JAMES

Their response was, "it's a HUD rule" (we saw that one com-ing) All of the Public Housing Authorities blame HUD when they know they are morally wrong.James was lucky he had J4H. We were able to save James from losing his subsidy apartment.

- PROVIDE 2ND CHANCE CREDIT CARDS
- REMOVE THE CREDIT CHECK BARRIER FOR FIP RELEASED WITHIN THE PAST 7 YEARS
- FORGIVE DEBT OCCURRED **ONCE A PERSON IS INCARCERATED**
- CREATE AN ALERT TO BLOCK CREDIT WHEN INDIVIDUALS ARE SENTENCED TO PRISON
- LOWER THE CREDIT SCORE RATING FOR FIP
